The St. Andrew Nativity School

Cassady Navarez, Director of Advancement

Cassady Navarez is a graduate of St. Pius X school and St. Mary's Academy. She went on to receive a Bachelor's degree from Oregon State University, a Masters in Teaching, and an MBA in Nonprofit Management from the University of Portland. She has taught middle school in the Archdiocese of Portland, worked on the admissions team at St. Mary's Academy, and worked in fundraising for the OHSU Doernbecher Children's Hospital before joining the Nativity team in December 2024.

St. Andrew Nativity School is a tuition-free Catholic, Jesuit middle school that serves young people of all faiths from underserved communities in Portland. All students who attend Nativity qualify for the federal free and reduced meal program sponsored by the USDA. The school was founded in 2001 by parishioners from St. Andrew Church with the support of the Archbishop of Portland and the Superior General of the Jesuits. Nativity School operates in partnership with Jesuits West and the NativityMiguel Coalition and its model seeks to empower its students in their intellectual, spiritual, and personal development to prepare them for high school, college, and career readiness, encouraging them to become "people for others", a key Jesuit tenant.

A core belief of the NativityMiguel Coalition, Nativity offers an extended school day providing a rigorous, standards-based curriculum, counseling support, enrichment classes, study hall, extracurricular activities, and year-round service-learning to instill the importance of giving back to the community. Students also participate in a three-week summer program.


Nativity's commitment to its students extends beyond graduation. Its Graduate Support Program supports students' transition to high school and post-secondary opportunities - including college and the workforce - by providing academic, emotional, and logistical support and programming that addresses their diverse needs and future goals. This program eases a graduate's transitions and supports, advocates for, and maintains a connection with each graduate far beyond their time at Nativity.

Nativity has strong partnerships with the Portland Catholic high schools, Edison High School, and Oregon Episcopal School, which provides the opportunity for Nativity graduates to attend these schools following 8th grade graduation. Nativity's annual operating budget is funded entirely by philanthropy - through individual, corporate, and foundation grants and donations.

Sara Beth Meyers, Author







Sara Beth Meyer is a wife, mother of nine, from 28-11, and grandmother of three. She met her husband in college in Minnesota. They were married on July 1, 1995, the feast of then Blessed Junipero Serra, and moved to Texas, earned a Master's of Theology while working as the DRE in their parish. Sara has been speaking, writing and singing about the love of the Lord ever since. Her first book series, The Gospels for Little Ones, is published by Marian Press.

Sara Meyer experienced a strong call to littleness and the joy of the Gospel in the face of the widespread adult perplexity, disagreement, and animosity during the COVID-19 pandemic. She was inspired to write in rhyming stanzas the Gospels for her growing family and shared her ideas with her friend and artist Allison Hsu. The children of both mothers helped in the process with their suggestions and creative artwork, leading to the publication of three books, each focused on one of the gospels.

From the gospels we all know about the beatitudes and the works of mercy. So it made sense as lessons for her children to donate the proceeds from the sale of the books towards non-profits: Casa Juan Diego, San Jose Clinic and St. Mary's Seminary, hosting a middle school Quo Vadis program. The Serra Club and the Vocation Director encouraged her to share her talents with other Serra Clubs and to create a retreat for middle schoolers at the Seminary.

Sara went on further to explain some practical ways to get kids on fire with their faith—Encourage them in multi-sensory ways, with music, asking questions throughout the day, in the home and in the garden. Decorate your home and yourself, with the different liturgical colors of the year. Engage them in service as kids love to be of serviceit gives them a sense of empowerment. Cultivate what they do well and look to see what are their strengths. 
